This third research seminar aims at **carrying on the discussions on the employment of persons with disabilities in the public sector** started in 2013 and 2014.

During this two-day seminar, we will **look at the answers provided by each country to the vignettes by working in a comparative perspective.**

These seminars are part of a project whose objectives are to:

- Map, across European countries involved in the project, the situation of the employment of persons with disabilities in the public sector: looking at policies enforced and at statistical data.
- Share concrete and innovative solutions as well as best practices on the employment of people with disabilities in the public sector.
