

Study of the population of people with disabilities working in the civil service in France

Project summary:

The analysis of the data collected by the Directorate of Research, Studies, Evaluation and Statistics (Drees) as part of the survey “Handicap-Santé – volet ménages” (Disability-Health – Household component) in 2008 as well as the data collected by the French National Institute of Statistics and Economic Studies (INSEE) as part of the Employment survey in 2011 (ad hoc module operated by the surveys ‘Labour Force Survey’, defined by the European Union) should not only allow us to better grasp the characteristics of people with disabilities working in the civil service but also to understand their place compared to the population within the private sector. This study is a first key stage of essential guidance because in order to understand the practices, it is necessary to know the population towards whom these practices are aimed. Furthermore, these analyses should allow us to better identify the difficulties experienced by the people with disabilities working in the civil service in France.
